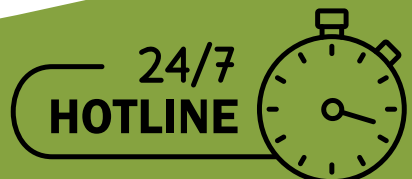
Family Abuse Shelter *of Miami County*
